

CHRISTOPHER DOCK MENNONITE HIGH SCHOOL
TURF FIELD RENTAL GUIDELINES

1. Rental groups using athletic fields must set-up a rental contract with the dates and times of use. Dates that need to be rescheduled due to inclement weather must be cleared with the school in advance.
2. Participants including coaches, players, and fans may not use tobacco products, consume alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, or use abusive language on the school's campus.
3. No cleats or turf shoes on the track.
4. No metal spikes are permitted; molded spikes on soccer style shoes are permitted, however *plastic screw-ins are not permitted*.
5. **When on the turf surface please adhere to the following guidelines:**
 - If turf surface is in any way defective after use, charges WILL be assessed
 - Food and Drink is not permitted (water is allowed)
 - No gum
 - Keep the entire area free of litter, mud, and dirt
 - No penetration of surface membrane or *significant repair costs will be assessed* (i.e., dragging sports goals will cause damage).
 - Use designated entrances only! Please instruct athletes that they are not permitted to climb over the fence.
 - Instruct your players not to use goals of another sport. Damage will occur if goals are used by a sport other than the sport designated.
6. Snow will **not** be removed from the turf. Do not attempt to remove snow. You may play on the field if it is snow-covered but do not attempt to remove the snow or it will damage the turf. You may reschedule or receive credit for time lost due to weather.
7. Christopher Dock Mennonite High School does not provide corner flags. You must use flags appropriate for turf or use cones. Do not puncture the turf in any way.
